Who doesn't love a port in a storm?


I soaked up all Cornwall had to offer - precarious paddle boarding in glorious sun, sketching on the lichen laden rocks and pootling around the rain soaked harbour.

While there I worked on some large canvases and a few collage boards, trying to capturing the mix of coastal heritage and raw wild beauty.


I love using collage as a means of layering history and time. I want my pieces to resonate with my experience of the place, even if most of the collage is covered by the painting process.

I'm always scouring places for found papers and objects to make an appearance in my work. A scribbled note, a lost shopping list, or a local poem found in a church charity stall, are my treasures.

These pieces below are developing, and I thought you may like to see how they've progressed from the first layers, in the top three, to where they are as they find their direction, in the bottom three images.



I normally work on board so it was a new experience for me to paint on this large canvas. I began with lots of blending over motifs I was interested in, which may make a reappearance later on. A few layers in and I'm loving the palette that's developing, but I'm still not sure which way up it will eventually land 🤪




